## PINOT GRIGIO 2018

### Region:

#### **South East Australia**

Grown and harvested from our Mildura vineyards which rest alongside our citrus groves at Red Cliffs in north west Victoria and from our Coonawarra estate vineyards in South Australia

### Harvest Date:

07-15 February 2018

### Wine Specifications:

Alc/Vol: 12.0%    pH: 3.27  
Acidity: 5.20g/L    RS: <2.0g/L

### Vinification:

Parcels of Pinot Grigio grapes were picked from family owned estate vineyards in Mildura, Victoria and Coonawarra, South Australia. Both parcels were fermented naturally in stainless steel fermenters until half way through (allowing complex and textural characteristics to develop), then a selected yeast was introduced to promote clean floral and citrus notes. The best parcels from both wineries were then blended.

### Winemaker's Notes:

#### Colour:

Medium straw.

#### Nose:

Delicate pear and stone fruit with subtle notes of lemon and orange blossom.

#### Palate:

Light, fresh fruit notes of pear with a touch of nectarine. A rich, smooth mouthfeel adds weight and complexity.

#### Cellaring Potential:

Perfect to enjoy now with increasing complexity over three years.

#### Ideal ways to enjoy AZAHARA:

Over dinner with friends. Sushi platters, roast chicken with lemon and garlic, or even a Thai green curry.
