Vinification: The 2017 Crackerjack Cabernet Sauvignon was fermented in Sweeping Arm Potter Fermenters with pump overs. Followed by malolactic fermentation and maturation on premium oak to add complexity and structure prior to final blending.

Winemaker’s Comments:

Colour: Deep red.

Nose: Rich red berry fruits, blackcurrant and plums with hints of spice and vanilla.

Palate: Ripe berries, spice and a hint of dark chocolate. Well-structured with toasty oak and fine tannins.

Cellaring Potential: Ready to drink now but will evolve more complex flavours up to five years.

Ideal Food Matches: Lamb cutlets, mushroom risotto or beef lasagne.
