Vinification: Cool natural fermentation in stainless steel vats until halfway, then inoculated with a yeast selected for its ability to emphasise floral and citrus characters. After fermentation, the wine was fined and bottled.

Winemaker’s Comments:

Colour: Medium straw.

Nose: Light citrus and floral notes with hints of pear and macadamia.

Palate: A weighty and complex wine with ripe nectarine and peach flavours and a clean, crisp finish.

Cellaring Potential: Ready to enjoy now, the wine will also develop more intense aromas and flavours over three years.

Ideal Food Matches: Perfect all types of seafood or a grilled chicken salad.
