Varietal:
Shiraz

Region:
Victoria. Harvested from our vineyards which rest alongside fruit groves at Red Cliffs near Mildura.

Harvest Date:
01 March - 23 March 2018

Wine Specifications:
Alc/Vol: 14.5% pH: 3.36
Acidity: 6.1g/L RS: <2.0g/L

Vinification:
The very best of our Shiraz parcels were fermented in sweeping-arm Potter fermenters to extract desired tannins and colour. Following pressing and malolactic fermentation, the most promising fractions were selected and aged with premium French oak until assemblage of the final blend.

Cellaring Potential:
Ready to drink now but can enjoy for up to four years.

Winemaker's Comments:

Colour:
Deep red.

Nose:
Ripe black plum and mulberry with hints of coffee and spicy, vanillin oak.

Palate:
Full flavoured and smooth with juicy dark berries and hints of spice and vanillin complemented by soft, supple tannins.

Ideal ways to enjoy AZAHARA:
Long lunches and weekend BBQs with friends. Try with barbecued leg of lamb with garlic and rosemary, spaghetti bolognese or some aged cheddar cheese.
