Vinification: Cool processing and fermentation preserved the delicate aromas in the juice and throughout fermentation.

Winemaker’s Comments:

Palate: Zingy and flavoursome, with citrus, passionfruit and pineapple notes. Medium weight with subtle minerality, balanced by natural freshness and a crisp, refreshing finish.

Cellaring Potential: Best enjoyed young. Serve chilled.

Ideal Food Matches: Oysters, fish and chips at the beach or a fresh goats cheese salad.
