Victoria. Harvested from our vineyards which rest alongside fruit groves at Red Cliffs near Mildura.

March 2016.

Vinification:
The very best of our Shiraz parcels were fermented in sweeping-arm Potter fermenters for seven days to aid extraction of tannins and flavour. At the pressing stage the most promising fractions were selected and aged for three months with premium French oak until final assemblage of the finished blend.

Winemaker's Comments:

Colour:
Deep ruby red.

Nose:
Ripe plum and cherry with hints of spicy oak.

Palate:
Full flavoured and juicy with rich red fruits. Hints of spice and vanillin complement by soft, supple tannins.

Ideal ways to enjoy AZAHARA:
Long lunches and weekend BBQs with friends. A juicy steak, sticky lamb ribs or sizzling Mongolian beef.

Cellaring Potential:
Ready to enjoy now but will also soften and develop complexity over five to seven years.
